

**PROCEDURES FOR  
CANADIAN NATIONAL SHUFFLEBOARD ASSOCIATION  
HALL OF FAME**

**A NOMINATIONS TO THE HALL OF FAME :**

- It is the privilege of each Canadian shuffleboard player to make nominations to the Hall of Fame committee in either the **Player** or **Special Award** category.
- Maximum of 3 for the Player Category and 2 for the Special Award per year.
- Nominations shall be sent to the Chairman of the Committee no later than 2 months prior to the CNSA annual meeting.
- Nominations must include a record of accomplishments, positions held including involvement dates of all activities.
- After reviewing the nominations the committee will recommend the qualifying nominees and send their information to the CNSA executive to review.
- Voting by the executive will take place before the CNSA annual Meeting, and the winners to be announced at the annual meeting.
- Presentations to be made at either the Annual Meeting or at an event chosen by the recipient (s)
- Presentation to consist of a framed certificate from the CNSA signed by the residing President and Hall of Fame chairperson.
- Picture and biography to be posted on the Virtual Hall of Fame on the [CNSA Shuffleboard Canada](http://www.cnsa-shuffleboard.com) website.

**B COMMITTEE MAKEUP**

- Committee Chairperson to be appointed by the CNSA President as soon as possible after the election of the president.
- Chairperson of the Committee shall appoint committee members for a 2 year term to coincide with the biannual election of officers to the CNSA board.
- This Committee shall screen nominations and recommend to the CNSA Board; persons, who in their opinion, are deemed worthy in accordance with the criteria established in the following categories :

**C SPECIAL AWARD**

**Qualifications for nomination :**

- Nominee must have an outstanding record of performance for the benefit of

Canadian shuffleboard as an executive, administrator, tournament official or a combination of positions.

- Nominee must have a continuous record of at least 7 years as member of a Canadian shuffleboard club or 5 years as a CNSA member.
- Letters of commendation from two Canadian shuffleboard players must accompany the request for nomination .

## **D PLAYER'S AWARD**

### **Qualifications for nomination :**

- In order to be nominated to the Hall of Fame for the Player's Award, a person must have a continuous Canadian record of at least 7 years as a player, tournament director or other wise have distinguished themselves with an outstanding contribution to Canadian Shuffleboard.
- A player must have an outstanding record of having won major tournament championship games and shown true sportsmanship. \*In addition their personal suitability, attitude and sportsmanship will be taken into consideration.
- Tournaments considered major are : International sanctioned tournaments, CNSA sanctioned tournaments, Provincial sanctioned tournaments and other tournaments identified by the CNSA board as major events within Canada. \*This revision added 2007 10 01 at Board Meeting in Midland, ON.
